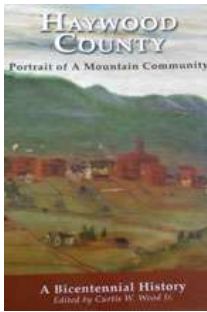

“Haywood County is blessed with a remarkable physical environment including most of the highest mountain peaks east of the Rockies, along with broad, rich river valley. Long before the first European settlers came, Native American peoples built and bunted here. Settlers and land speculators began to arrive in the 1780s and to lay the foundations for historic communities. Haywood County was established in 1808.

In the years before the Civil War, a synthesis of Scots Irish, English, German, African American and other ethnic groups populated the river valleys and coves.”
